

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT CHANGES FOR FALL 2024
ASPER SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

The following changes noted in blue will come into effect for the 2024-2025 application cycle. Applications to this cycle will open in early November 2023. The intent of this document is to give future applicants sufficient time to complete the new prerequisites course(s) prior to their application.

All applicants **applying under Track 1** must meet the following basic requirements: the successful completion of the following 24 credit hours with no grade lower than 'C' in each of the required courses. Courses graded as "Pass" or equivalent cannot be used to fulfill the course requirements. Applicants must complete the Track 1 Requirements by the end of the Winter exam period.
