Why Extended Education students?

Extended Education Industry Placement students are international students and working professionals studying Applied Business Analysis, Applied Business Management or Applied Human Resource Management with UM Extended Education. Many bring a wealth of international experience from previous careers including accounting and finance, architecture and engineering, education and health care, and HR and administration. They are eager to gain experience in the Canadian workplace and put their knowledge to work for you. As part of a 12 month, full-time program package, students complete a UM Certificate and UM Letter of Accomplishment in Career Preparation in the first 10 months followed by a Industry Experience in the last two months of study. Students complete their Industry Placements within the last two months of study.
