

Locker Rental Information Student's Architectural Society (SAS)

Locker Disclaimer:

During the Fall and Winter terms of the academic year lockers in the John A. Russell building and Architecture 2 tunnels are only rented through SAS. Lockers in other buildings are under the jurisdiction of that particular building's specific academic department(s).

Students may only use the locker assigned to them. Locks put on unassigned lockers will be removed. Students are personally responsible for the contents of their lockers. It is not advisable to leave valuables (laptop computers, wallets, jewelry, etc.) in lockers. SAS and the Faculty of Architecture will not, under any circumstances, accept responsibility for the loss, damage, removal of locks or locker contents, or the loss of locker contents after removal.

In the event a lock combination is lost, photo ID must be presented to SAS by the locker occupant.

ALL locks and contents of lockers must be removed by Thursday, April 30th, 2020. As of Friday, May 1st, any remaining locks and/or contents will be removed from all lockers. Warning emails will be sent out closer to the rental end date. When locks are cut off, contents are discarded or donated to charity.

Locker FAQs

How do I rent a locker?

Lockers will be sold in the basement level of John A. Russel Building on Aug. 23, Sept. 4, 5, & 6 from 11:00-1:00pm. After this period of selling student may contact faumgrad2020@gmail.com to rent a locker. (forms must be filled out and payment made before placing lock on locker).

A short registration form will be filled out stating that you understand the terms and conditions of your locker rental. This registration form will also collect your contact information and will be a mandatory requirement for your rental. Forms will be provided at the payment tables.

How much is it to rent a locker?

Lockers are available for faculty students at \$25 for the full year on Aug 23, Sept 4, 5, and 6.

Lockers will be made available to outside the faculty for \$30 following all selling dates.

What forms of payment do you accept?

We accept cash payment only. We may be able to accept debit/credit card payments, but no guarantee so bring cash to ensure locker rental. Payments will be accepted in person, tables will be set up in the basement of JAR from 11:00am - 1:00pm. Any inquiry for lockers after the sale date will have to be emailed to faumgrad2020@gmail.com.

Where are the lockers located?

All lockers are located in the basement tunnel from JAR to Architecture 2.

Can I request a locker for Fall now and Winter later?

Locker rentals span both terms; rentals for individual terms are not available.

When can I start to use my locker?

You can start using your locker as soon as your payment and registration form have been completed.

Are lockers refundable if I change my mind?

No, they are not.

Can I change lockers?

No. All locker assignments are final. No changes will be permitted. Please choose your preferred area/locker number before coming to the table.

Is a lock provided?

No. You must provide your own lock.

What if I cannot open my lock (lost a key or combination)?

In the event a lock combination is lost, photo ID must be presented to SAS by the locker occupant; lock will be cut for you, and new lock will have to be placed on locker. Contact us through email: faumgrad2020@gmail.com

Can I leave my laptop in my locker?

Students are personally responsible for the contents of their lockers. It is not advisable to leave valuables (laptop computers, wallets, jewelry, etc.) in lockers. SAS and the Faculty of Architecture will not, under any circumstances, accept responsibility for the loss, damage, removal of locks or locker contents, or the loss of locker contents after removal.

When do lockers have to be emptied out?

All locks and contents of lockers must be removed by Thursday, April 30th, 2020. As of Friday, May 1st, 2020 any remaining locks and/or contents will be removed from all lockers.
