To be eligible for the travel subsidy, graduate students

1. Must be enrolled in an M.A. or PhD program in October 2012
2. Must register for the conference and pay the registration fee by Sept. 17, 2012
3. Hand in the application form for the subsidy and a text file (doc, docx, rtf) of paper by email as of Sept. 17, 2012 (note the paper should be a complete draft close to the paper, max. 10 pages double spaced, actually presented in Winnipeg but of course can be adjusted / revised in the weeks before the conference).
4. Must have incurred travel costs or other costs in relation to the conference (registration, accommodation) of at least \$200 that are not reimbursed by other sources.
