The book *Starving Ukraine* will be introduced by the author. Through an analysis of newspapers, political speeches, and protests, the book examines both Canada's reporting of the Holodomor and the country's response to it.

Serge Cipko is Assistant Director (Research) at the Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies. He is the author of *Ukrainians in Argentina, 1897-1950: The Making of a Community* (2011) and *St. Josaphat Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral, Edmonton: A History (1902-2002)* (2009), and the



co-author (with Glenna Roberts) of *One Way Ticket: The Soviet Return to the Homeland Campaign, 1955-1960* (2008).
