All Year 2, Early Years students with full-time status in the After Degree B.Ed. program will be taking two mandatory 6 credit hour courses during the fall term. A portion of these courses will be taught in partnership with early years schools in the Seven Oaks School Division. For the 2020/2021 Academic Year, the courses will be mostly taught in a remote learning environment with in-school learning during the weeks of January 5 to 15, 2021. You will be working closely with teachers and your instructors through video observation and through teacher student conferencing. Please note that the expectations of these school-based courses are different than the practicum courses.
