Education Graduate Student Research Awards

Purpose: To support Faculty of Education graduate students' Thesis or Dissertation research

Eligibility: Part-time and full-time Education graduate students who meet the following criteria:

- Are in good academic standing in their program
- Have successfully defended their thesis proposal within the last twelve (12) months or are doing their dissertation research
- Do not hold any major research funding awards (e.g., SSHRC, UMGF, etc.)

Value: the value of the award is up to \$1,000

Application Process and Deadlines:

- Rolling application
- Student must submit the following documentation:
 - A completed application form (page 6).
 - A reference from an individual familiar with the individual's research work
 - A signed copy of thesis proposal defence report form
 - A budget outlining the expected costs for the student's research endeavours

Evaluation Criteria:

Applications to this Award will be reviewed by the Associate Dean (Graduate Programs & Research) based on all of the following criteria:

- Scholarly works of the student
- Awards and scholarships received
- The overall quality of the research proposal

Conditions of the Award:

- Research supported by the Graduate Student Research Award must comply with the University policies on the conduct of research, specifically the University policy on research ethics and, where applicable, the University policies on research involving the use of human subjects
- Funds must be used for the project and purposes described in the application
- Students can access this Award only once during their program of studies
- Within three months of successful completion of the final thesis defence, a report must be submitted to the Associate Dean (Graduate Programs & Research). This report should not exceed one page and should describe: what was accomplished; a summary of any research findings; plans for research dissemination; and plans for future research, if applicable
- Students are encouraged to present their thesis findings at the annual Faculty of Education's Graduate Students' Research Symposium

Dr. R. Hedley Memorial Research Fund

Purpose: To provide research support for projects that demonstrate the potential for improving the quality of education in Manitoba

Background: The *Dr. R. Hedley Memorial Research Fund* is established as a perpetual memorial to Dr. R.L. Hedley, former faculty member and Associate Dean of the Faculty of Education until 1982

Eligibility: Part-time or Full-time Faculty of Education graduate students in the Master's thesis route or in the PhD program who are in good academic standing

Value: One \$2,000 award or two \$1,000 awards

Application Process and Deadlines:

- Applications will be received annually by November 15
- Student must submit the following documentation:
 - A completed application form (page 6)
 - A reference from an individual familiar with the individual's research work
 - A budget outlining the expected costs for the student's research endeavours

Evaluation Process:

The Dean of the Faculty of Education will appoint a committee of three referees who shall receive and judge applications for research support, and make recommendations to the Dean who will make the final decisions. Applications will be reviewed based on all of the following criteria:

- Scholarly works of the student
- Awards and scholarships received
- The overall quality and impact of the research proposal

Conditions of the Award:

- Research supported by the Dr. R. Hedley Memorial Research Fund must comply with the University policies on the conduct of research, specifically the University policy on research ethics and, where applicable, the University policies on research involving the use of human subjects
- Funds must be used for the project and purposes described in the application
- Students can access this Award only once during their program of studies
- Within three months of successful completion of the final thesis defence, a report must be submitted to the Associate Dean (Graduate Programs & Research). This report should not exceed one page and should describe: what was accomplished; a summary of any research findings; plans for research dissemination; and plans for future research, if applicable

Arthur Stinner Memorial Fellowship in Science Education Research Award

Background: An endowment fund has been established in memory of Arthur Stinner. Dr. Stinner was a professor of science education in the Faculty of Education and was an internationally known physics education scholar with a specific interest in ways to include history and philosophy of science in school science education.

Purpose: This Fellowship has been created to support a graduate student in the Faculty of Education who is beginning his/her research focused on humanistic approaches to science education.

Eligibility: Each year, the available annual interest from the fund will be used to offer one scholarship to a graduate student who:

- is enrolled full-time in the Faculty of Graduate Studies in a Master's thesis-based route, or doctoral program delivered by the Faculty of Education at the University of Manitoba;
- has achieved a minimum degree grade point average of 3.50 (or equivalent) in the last 60 credit hours of study; and
- is conducting or has proposed to conduct research focused on humanistic approaches to science education (e.g. history and philosophy of science in science teaching)

Value: One \$530.00 award is available annually; this amount may vary slightly in each year

Application Process and Deadlines:

- Applications will be received annually by June 15
- Student must submit the following documentation:
 - A cover letter (maximum 250 words) that describes the status and progress of the applicant's program of studies;
 - An outline (maximum 500 words) that describes the applicant's proposed research project;
 - A *curriculum vitae*;
 - A completed application form (page 6)
 - A reference from an individual familiar with the individual's research work
 - A set of current academic transcripts

Evaluation Process:

Graduate Student Conference Travel Awards

Purpose: To support Faculty of Education graduate students who are presenting at academic conferences

Eligibility: Part-time and Full-time Education Graduate students who meet the following criteria and conditions:

- Are in good academic standing in their program
- Have been accepted to present at a research conference sponsored by a recognized national or international organization (papers/posters must be relevant to the applicant's program of study)
- Relevance of the conference to the student's program of study

Value:

- Up to \$500 for Canadian conferences
- Up to \$750 for international conferences

Preference:

The Education Graduate Student Conference Award is intended to supplement students' conference travel. Students are expected to apply for funding to the Faculty of Graduate Studies (FGS) and to the University of Manitoba Graduate Student Association (UMGSA), if they are eligible. Preference will be given to those who will be receiving funding from either or both of these sources.

Application Process and Guidelines:

- Rolling application. Students are encouraged to apply prior to the conference; however, applications received within one month after the conference has ended may be considered
- Student must submit the following documentation:
 - A completed application form
 - Confirmation that the paper/poster has been accepted by the conference organizers
 - A statement of support from the student's advisor
 - One page abstract of paper being presented
 - *Confirmation/Proof of funding from FGS, UMGSA or other sources (if none, please indicate)
 - A budget outlining the expected travel costs
 - Original receipts for all expenses and boarding passes (must be submitted within one month after the conference)

***Note: Students applying for or receiving funding must submit proof of funding sources and amounts, together with the Conference Travel Award package Part I and II. Part III must be submitted by the applicant to the referee who submits directly from their email address to adgr.education@umanitoba.ca**

Conditions of the Award:

- Funds must be used for travel expenses directly related to the conference
- Students may access this Award twice within the duration of their graduate program
- Students are encouraged to present their conference papers at the annual Faculty of Education Graduate Students' Research Symposium
- Funds will not be released until proof of funding is provided (if applicable)

Evaluation Criteria:

The Associate Dean (Graduate Programs & Research) will review all applications for approval based on the eligibility criteria stated above
