



## NOTIFICATION OF CONCERN

The Faculty Advisor will complete this form for any Teacher Candidate experiencing significant difficulty in the practicum. Where possible, an NOC should be filed **by the third week of the practicum block**. However, an NOC can be filed at any time. The form may be handwritten or typed and additional documentation may be attached as needed. The FA will **fax (204-474-7551), email or deliver the completed NOC to the Director, School Experiences Office** as soon after the required signatures have been obtained as possible.

Failure by the TC to meet the Practicum Expectations and adequately address the concerns identified in the NOC may lead to a grade of "Fail" in the practicum. TCs may wish to seek support and guidance from Academic Student Services, Student Advocacy and/or Student Accessibility Services at the University of Manitoba in addition to consulting with their Faculty Advisor and Cooperating Teacher(s).
