

Field School Equipment List

Equipment and other items required. You will need to have the following equipment/items for field-school.

A. Fieldwork-related

1. Physics-type hard-cover log book (alternating graph pages would be useful) (**compulsory**)
2. Selection of pencils and pens for recording field data (plus erasers, sharpeners *etc*)
3. Clip board and bull-dog clips for work in the wind
4. Calculator
5. USB flash drive for storing and transporting electronic data and reports
6. Roll of transparent tape
7. (If available) Geological hammer, hand lens, and magnet
8. Marker pens
9. Sturdy ruler
10. A pack of foam ear-plugs for hammer seismic work (and snoring room-mates).

B. Personal equipment

1. Insect repellent and sunscreen
2. Watch (with a seconds display)
3. Pack for day work
4. Water bottle and/or thermos flask for day work
5. Sleeping bag/linen/blanket for Star Lake accommodation
6. Lunches/snacks on days we leave from, or are based in, Winnipeg
7. Pocket first aid kit
8. Pocket knife or equivalent
9. Cash to pay for meals (except at Star Lake)

C. Clothing

1. Sturdy boots for work in the shield and on uneven terrain (non-magnetic boots are an advantage)
2. Boots for working in wet or muddy conditions
3. Clothing for temperatures between -5° and 35°
4. Clothing for light rain conditions and snow conditions
5. Hat (for sun protection and/or warmth depending on conditions)
6. Gloves for warmth and gloves for protection (e.g. work or gardening gloves).
7. Sunglasses
8. Toiletries and any medications required.
9. Small pack or suitcase for two to three day trips
