

**Riddell Faculty of Environment, Earth, and Resources
Undergraduate Admission Scholarships**

The Clayton H. Riddell Faculty of Environment, Earth, and Resources offers five scholarships, valued at \$1,000 each, to undergraduate students who:

- (1) have completed a minimum of 24 credit hours in University 1;
- (2) in the next ensuing academic session, are enrolled full-time in their second year of study, in any baccalaureate degree program offered in the Clayton H. Riddell Faculty of Environment, Earth, and Resources;
- (3) are the five highest ranking students admitted to the Faculty in the year in which the award is tenable based on a minimum degree grade point average of 3.5.

In the event of a tie, the scholarship will be offered to the student who has completed the largest number of higher level courses in their first year of study.

The selection committee will be the Awards and Honours Committee of the Clayton H. Riddell Faculty of Environment, Earth, and Resources.
