## B. APPLICANT CATEGORIES

### 1. Direct Entry High School Students:

Applicants in this category can apply directly from a Manitoba high school (or the equivalent) and will have met the General Entrance and Specific Admission Requirements as listed in the Direct Entry Application Information Bulletin.

### 2. REGULAR APPLICANTS

Applicants considered for admission on the basis of academic performance. All applicants will be automatically evaluated in this category. Additional evaluation will take place for students who chose the Special Consideration Category as described below.

### 3. SPECIAL CONSIDERATION APPLICANTS

Applicants who may not be competitive in the Regular applicant category may select one of the following sub-categories:

- a. Occupational Background. Eligible applicants will have a minimum of two years of work experience in a related health field.
- b. Aboriginal Peoples of Canada. Eligible applicants will be from the Indigenous populations of Canada.
