Re: Student volunteers

The Rady Faculty of Health Sciences Deanery is encouraging student volunteers to assist the health-care system during the COVID-19 pandemic. The link below will take you to a google sheet where you can indicate your availability to volunteer for Screening or Occupational and Environmental Safety & Health (OESH.) Please show up 15 minutes before your shift starts.

Screening will be conducted at two locations- Health Sciences Centre and Grace Hospital. This will include asking all visitors entering the hospital a series of questions and based on their responses, directing them to the appropriate place. This will also include relaying information about the visitor restriction and other relevant information. You will be provided a place to store your personal belongings.

For HSC Screening, please report to Central Staff Office GC210 by the Cafeteria and for Grace Hospital, you will report to the main front entrance and be greeted there. If you are interested in volunteering for screening please indicate the times you are available on the Screening HSC or Screening Grace tabs in the spreadsheet in the link below.

For OESH, you will report to Concordia Hip and Knee Institute, 1155 Concordia Avenue (on the north side of the building. Shoppers Drug Mart and Medical Clinic are on the south side). Park in one of the stalls marked WRHA (please do not park in Shoppers Drug Mart parking lot.) Use the phone in the second floor lobby to call into reception. All visitors must provide reception with: their name and license plate and purpose of their visit (U of M student volunteer to OESH).
