**Date:** Tuesday June 6, 2017

**Details:** As part of Resident Research Day we will be holding a 3-minute thesis competition, open to residents from all RCPSC programs. Applicants will be nominated by their programs for the opportunity to compete – more application details to follow in 2017.

**What is a 3-Minute Thesis?:** Developed by the University of Queensland, the 3-Minute Thesis provides a challenging yet concise format in which to present a research project. General concepts include:

- **One single, static PowerPoint slide** - no effects/animation or movement
- **No additional props or media permitted**
- **Exactly 3 minutes to present** – exceeding 3 minutes will result in disqualification
