## **BACKGROUND**

The decision to withdrawal from medical residency requires serious consideration and should be made only following extensive consultation with counseling supports available to residents. A resident may choose to withdraw from his/her residency program for a number of reasons including the following:

- Ongoing issues with academic performance
- Career choice
- Personal reasons
- Extended leave of absence making circumstances around return difficult

# **DEFINITIONS**

**ARETS –** Alternate Resident Entry & Transfer Subcommittee is the PGME Subcommittee responsible for managing alternate resident routes of entry to Residency Programs

**CPSM** – College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba

Home Program - is the Residency Program in which postgraduate medical trainee is based

PARIM - Professional Association of Residents and Interns of Manitoba

**PGME** – Postgraduate Medical Education

**WRHA** – Winnipeg Regional Health Authority

#### 1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 Provide specific guidelines regarding a resident's voluntary withdrawal from a Residency Program
  - 1.1.1 This policy does not include resident transfer to another Residency Program or dismissal from a Residency Program.

## 2. STATEMENT OF POLICY

- 2.1 A resident may voluntarily withdraw from training in a Residency Program/ terminate employment as a resident. This intent is subject to a minimum of four (4) weeks written notice to his/her Home Residency Program Director.
- 2.2. Withdrawal does not prevent a resident from reapplying to their previous residency program or another residency program within PGME in the second iteration of the CaRMS match.
- 2.3 Any actions in progress at the time of withdrawal (e.g. resident on leave of absence; on suspension; on probation) will be discontinued.
- 2.4 Positions that have been vacated are not lost and are eligible to be filled.

# 3. PROCEDURES

- 3.1. A resident wishing to withdraw from his/her Residency Program must meet with his/her Residency Program Director, who will seek consultation with the Associate Dean, PGME.
- 3.2 After consultation and final determination, the resident must provide written notice of his/her intent to withdraw to his/her Residency Program Director.
- 3.3 The Program Director will provide a copy of the resident's written notice to the Office of the Associate Dean, PGME within 24 hours of receipt.
- 3.4 The Office of the Associate Dean, PGME will provide written notification that a resident has withdrawn to the following:
  - 3.4.1 PARIM, within 24 hours of notification of such action
  - 3.4.2 Employer (usually WRHA)
  - 3.4.3 CPSM
- 3.5 The PGME Office will coordinate with the Employer to make the appropriate payroll adjustments for any unused vacation accrued or adjustments for any negative vacation or sick leave balances.
- 3.6 Residents' suspension and dismissal are covered under the PGME policy on Resident Assessment, Promotion, Remediation, Probation, Suspension and Dismissal.
- 3.7 Management of the vacant spot created by a resident withdrawal will require the combined input from the Associate Dean, PGME, the PGME ARETS Subcommittee, the relevant Residency Program Committee and the WRHA Residency Funding Advisory Committee.
