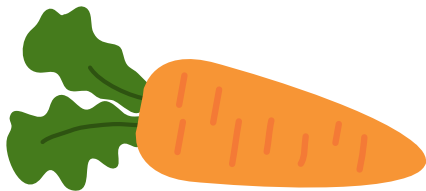
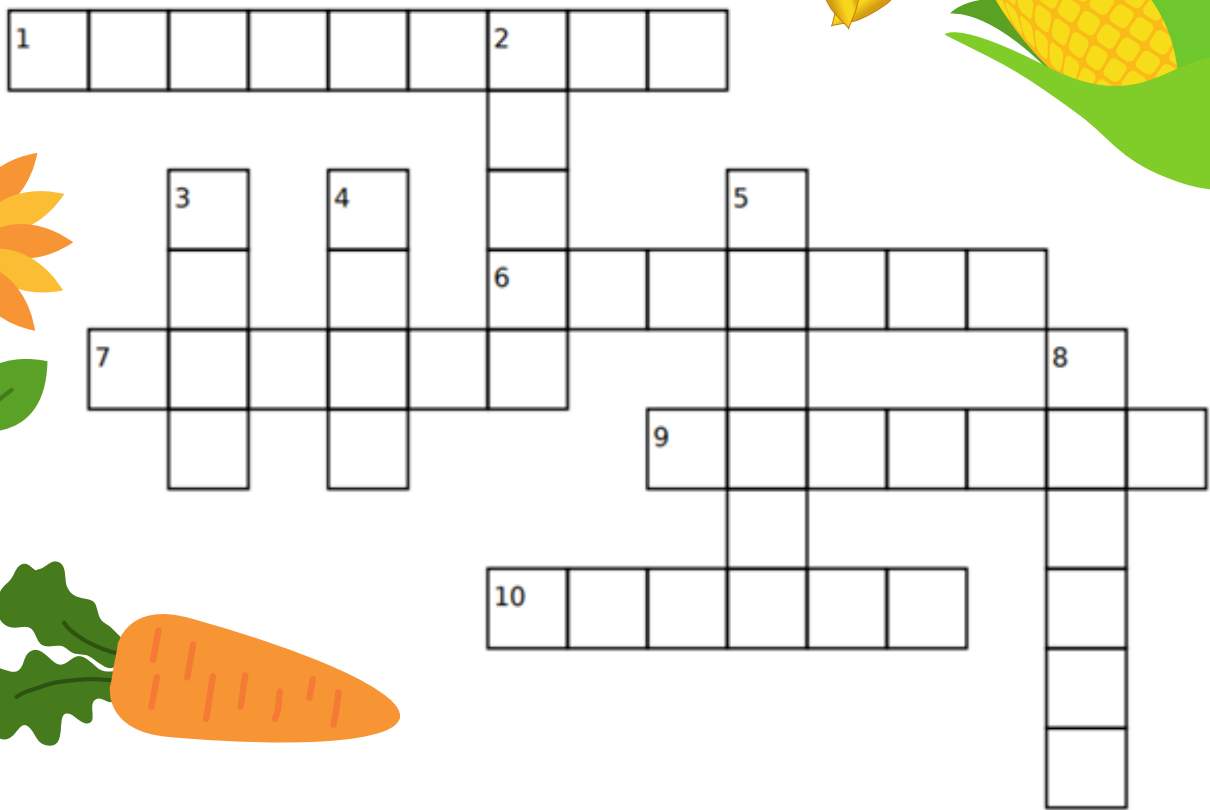
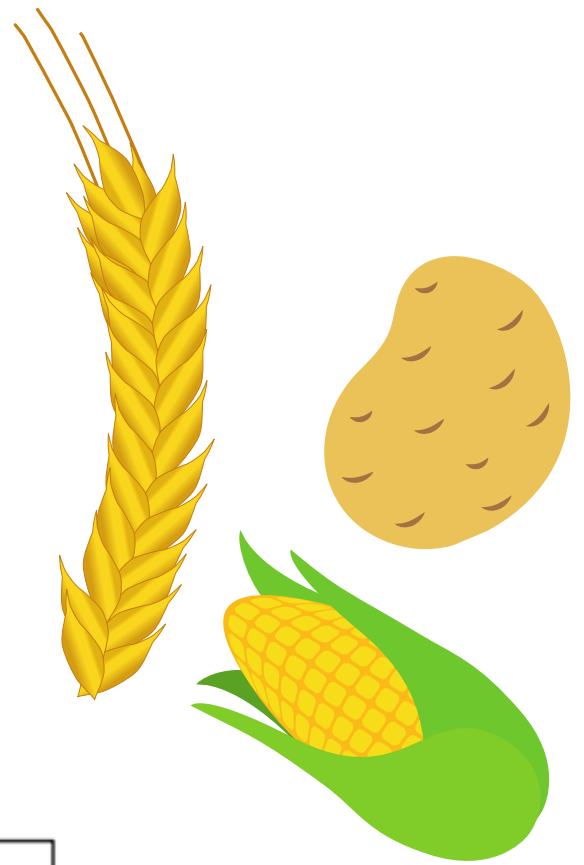


Manitoba Crops Crossword
