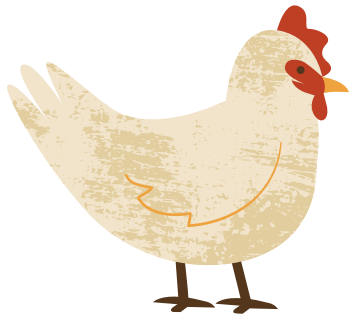


CHIRPY CHICKEN CROSSWORD

- A1. This is what we call a chicken that is raised for meat.

- A5. This person's job is to house, care for and raise broiler chickens.
