Terms of Reference

Caroline A. Cope Award for Excellence in Oncology Research

An endowment fund was established at the University of Manitoba through a bequest from Ms. Caroline A. Cope to support students demonstrating excellence in cancer research.

Each year, the available annual income from the fund will be used to provide one or more scholarships to graduate or postgraduate students who:

1. are enrolled as either:
 - 1.1. full-time in the Faculty of Graduate Studies in a master's or doctoral program delivered by a department in the Max Rady College of Medicine; or
 - 1.2. full-time in the Postgraduate Medical Education Program, either as a resident or as a fellow, in good standing;
2. have achieved either:
 - 2.1. as a graduate student, a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5 (or equivalent) in the graduate program;
 - 2.2. as a Post Graduate Medical Education student, is in good standing.
3. have demonstrated research excellence in the area of oncology.

Candidates will be required to submit an application that will consist of:

- (i) a description of their proposed or ongoing research (maximum 500 words),
- (ii) a curriculum vitae, and
- (iii) two academic letters of reference from professors at a post-secondary institution.

The selection committee will have the discretion to determine the number and value of scholarships offered each year as outlined above, based on the available annual income.

The selection committee will be the Major Awards Committee of the Max Rady College of Medicine.

Any graduate student recipients named to receive the scholarship under category 1.1 above will be reported through the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

This agreement may be amended by the mutual consent of the donor (or designate) and the University of Manitoba. All such amendments shall be in writing.

In the absence of the donor (or designate), and providing all reasonable efforts have been made to consult, the Board of Governors of the University of Manitoba has the right to modify the terms of this award if, because of changed conditions, it becomes necessary to do so.

Such modification shall conform as closely as possible to the expressed intention of the donor in establishing the award.
