4.1 Course and Program Modifications within Community Health Sciences

4.1.1 To modify the requirements of the Bachelor of Human Ecology, Family Social Sciences Degree Program such that SOC 1200 *Introduction to Sociology*, 6 credits will be replaced by SOC 1000 *Introduction to Sociology*, 3 credits.
4.1.2 To modify pre-requisites for the courses FMLY 2800, FMLY 3220, and FMLY 3240, such that SOC 1000 is added as a pre-requisite along with the former SOC 1200.

4.1.3 To add PSYC 2250, Introduction to Psychological Research, as a prerequisite for FMLY 3780, Introduction to the Development of Programs for *Children and Families*, and FMLY 3790, *Introduction to the Evaluation of Programs for Children and Families*, which are required courses in the Interdisciplinary Health Program (IHP).

It was MOVED AND SECONDED (S. Bruce and P. Cattini) that the course and program modifications within Community Health Sciences be approved.
