#### 8. New Business

#### 8.1 Program Expansion

Dean Nickerson advised that the expansion program proposals including UGME, Nurse Practitioner, MPAS, Occupational Therapy, and Physical Therapy were supported by both Senate and the University Board of Governors. The University President followed up with a letter, including the submitted proposal to the Ministry of Advanced Education Skills and Immigration (AESI). The proposals, in addition to operating funds, include capital for the building of space within the Bannatyne campus to allow for growth accommodation. Currently in discussions with government for capital investment, government is committed to working with us. The University President has been clear that, until we have finalization of both capital and operating dollars, we are not able to increase seat capacity. Should we receive formal notification for funding by mid-May, will increase UGME seat capacity to 125 from 110 for the next academic year. Noted PGME has been confirmed for funding and expansion is underway.

The original proposal included potential to increase to 150 seats with inclusion of the Brandon satellite campus; however, we are not able, within the timeframe, to proceed through university process and be prepared by this fall. We are dedicated to work with the Brandon site over the next to year to review costing.

Continue to work with government around the MPAS and Nurse Practitioner expansions which government views as intake for the 2024 academic year.

#### 8.2 CaRMS

Nationally the University of Manitoba had the best Match. The 13 unfilled family medicine positions were filled in the second iteration. We were left with three unfilled positions, two in psychiatry and one in clinical micro-biology, interest has been expressed for these.
