L MacDonald let DCC know that the Office of Interprofessional Education is having to re-think the manner in which the educational experiences will be delivered across the Rady Faculty due to changes in enrollment and other factors. Dentistry will maintain the 'held' time for 2023-24 and will have other programs join them in activities as available. The IPE Office is working with CATL to develop modules/learning activities to address any gaps. The Office is needing to re-think the experiential learning model based on new enrollment parameters.

A Cholakis received information from Rady regarding incorporating an anti-racism statement in Course Outlines or appending a statement to course materials. These statements may or may not require student signatures. More information will be forthcoming. If to be included with the Course Outline, this will be incorporated in the Course Outline Template.
