

Parking

East Entrance (blue star)

Access the parking lot from Darling Street. This parking lot is in front of the Day Hospital (see attached map). You must go into the Day Hospital to pay at the parking pay station. There is also an option to pay by smart phone. Accessible parking is available (Pink Circle).

Street Parking (yellow lines)

Street parking is free on surrounding streets for 1 or 2 hours. Street parking is frequently patrolled.

Winnipeg Transit

Bus routes 107 and 895 arrive at the main entrance of Riverview. It is a 10-minute walk from the main entrance to SLIC (blue star).

Cancellation and Missed Appointment Policy
