- ✓ Common property (fishing spots) X State property
- ✓ Informal institutions (local rules) X Formal institutions
- (ii) Related to access to marine resources:
- √ Small scale fishers X Large scale fishers
- ✓ Artisanal fishers X Protected Area managers
- (iii) Related to fisheries and protected areas management:
- ✓ Prevalence of top-down management
- ✓ Lack of fishermen representation, power and participation in management arenas
- ✓ Lack of enforcement over large fisheries X excessive enforcement over

small fisheries



Characterizing Fishing Agreements in Paraty (started in June 2009):
□ Institutional Goal: Project for a Legal Normative Instrument
□ Main Theme: Artisanal Fisheries
□ Main Fisheries Issue: Participative proposal for co-management.
☐ Scale: regional (Ilha Grande Bay)
□ Current state: planning Phase and discussion of future actions in public meetings of the Fishing Agreements Project and closed meeting
of the Collaborative Management Council of the lina Grande Bay
□ <b>Results:</b> Fisheries Participatory Appraisal concluded on November 2011 by UFRJ and FIPERJ
□Leading organizations:
(i) Fisheries Ministry <i>(MPA)</i>
(ii) Fisheries Institute and Foundation of Rio de Janeiro State (FIPERJ) (iii) Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (UFRJ)
□ Knowledge: local, technical and scientific
☐ <b>Meetings observed:</b> 5 (2009-2010); Fishing Agreements and the Workshop for collaborative management and artisanal fishers network

	🗖 Scale. regional (2 states, several municipalities, different ecosystems)		
	□ Current state: Characterization of the artisanal fisheries in Trindade is concluded. Data was validated by fishermen		
	□ Results at the moment: A negotiation regarding an agreement on fishing rules within a protected area started but had not continuity because managers were not open to negotiate		
	□ Leading organization: Chico Mendes Institute for Biodiversity Conservation (ICMBio)		
	□ <i>Partnerships:</i> ONGs and Government		
	□ Knowledge: local and scientific		
	☐ <b>Meetings observed:</b> 8 (2010); Consultive Council of the Mosaico Bocaina and Workshops in Trindade

☐ Scale: regional (2 municipalities; islands in the Ilha Grande Bay)		
□Current state:		
(i)The legislation review is at a standstill		
□ Leading organization: Chico Mendes Institute for Biodiversity Conservation (ICMBio)		
□ <i>Partnerships:</i> Government (municipal and federal)		
□ <i>Knowledge:</i> technical and scientific		
☐ <i>Meetings observed:</i> 5 (2010); Consultive Council of the ESEC Tamoios and Fishery legislation review.		




