Alberta	3,575	3,575	3,575	Graduate fees were restructured. Effective Fall 2011, newly admitted students registered in thesis-based programs are assessed program fees rather than fees per course. Reduced thesis-only fee available to only those admitted prior to Fall 2011. A Maintaining Registration Fee of \$1218 (\$609 per term) is charged for keeping a program active but not completing any work.
British Columbia	4,264	4,264	1,948	After paying \$1421 for six semesters Masters students pay a flat rate continuing fee of \$1948 per year. If a Master's Degree is not awarded within a period of five years from initial registration, a student may, with permission, be granted an extension. Extension fees are \$2736 per year. After paying \$1421 for nine semesters Ph.D. students pay a flat rate continuing fee of \$1948 per year. If a Doctoral Degree is not awarded within a period of six years from initial registration, a student may, with permission, be granted an extension. Extension fees are \$2736 per year.
McGill <sup>4</sup>	5,858	2,168	1,968	Fee of \$1968 is charged for an Additional Session or Non-Thesis Extension.
Manitoba	4,166	4,166	672	A full-time Masters student is assessed tuition fees of \$4,166 in the first year of registration in a one-year program, and in each of the first two years of registration in a two-year program. Thereafter, continuing fees are assessed each year until completion of the program. Ph.D. students are assessed tuition fees of \$4,166 annually for two years. Thereafter, continuing fees are assessed each year until completion of the program.
McMaster	6,489	6,489	5,796-6,249	Masters and Ph.D. students pay \$6489 for term one, \$6249 for terms 2 to 4, \$6018 for terms 5 to 7, and \$5796 for terms 8 or greater. Ph.D. students in terms 13 or greater will be charged tuition at a discounted rate. Discounted fees are \$965 / term or \$2895 / year.

Western <sup>5</sup>	6,261	6,261	6,261	Students continue to pay full tuition each additional semester (\$2087 / semester for most Arts and Science programs).
Saskatchewan	3,309	3,309	3,309	Tuition fees are \$1,103 per four-month term for the duration of graduate studies.
Toronto	6,885	6,885	6,885	No continuing fees, students pay entire cost of tuition each additional year.
Dalhousie	6,573-7,473	6,900-7,809	2,046	After paying a flat rate for the duration of the program (usually two years), students pay a continuing registration fee of \$682 per term.

1. Graduate fees represent those for standard Arts and Science programs. Where a range is given fees vary by program.
2. Continuing fees have been calculated to reflect what a student would pay for an additional year of study in order to make fees comparable across institutions.
3. One calendar year is equal to three semesters.
4. The Masters fee represented is the fee that non-Quebec Canadian students pay. All Canadians, regardless of province, pay the same fee for a Ph.D. program.
5. The University of Western Ontario changed its name to Western University in 2012.
