After paying \$888 for twelve semesters, Ph.D. students pay 8.15% of the total program fee (i.e. \$868), per semester.
Alberta <sup>5</sup>	3,662	3,662	3,662	Commencing Fall 2011, newly admitted students registered in thesis-based programs are assessed program fees rather than fees per course.
British Columbia	4,802	4,802	2,194	After paying \$1,601 for six semesters, Masters students pay a flat rate continuing fee of \$2,194 per annum. If a Master's Degree is not awarded within a period of five years from initial registration, a student may, with permission, be granted an extension. Extension fees are \$3,081 per annum. After paying \$1,601 for nine semesters, Ph.D. students pay a flat rate continuing fee of \$2,194 per annum. If a Doctoral Degree is not awarded within a period of six years from initial registration, a student may, with permission, be granted an extension. Extension fees are \$3,081 per year.
McGill <sup>6</sup>	7,403	2,391	2,170	Fee of \$2,170 is charged for an Additional Session.
Manitoba	4,655	4,655	750	A full-time Masters student is assessed tuition fees of \$4,655 in the first year of registration in a one-year program, and in each of the first two years of registration in a two-year program. Thereafter, continuing fees are assessed each year until completion of the program. Ph.D. students are assessed tuition fees of \$4,655 annually for two years. Thereafter, continuing fees are assessed each year until completion of the program.
McMaster	7,008	7,008	7,008	Masters and Ph.D. students pay \$7,008 for all terms. Ph.D. students in terms 13 or greater are charged at a discounted rate (\$3,504 per annum).

Western <sup>7</sup>	6,991	6,991	6,991	Students continue to pay full tuition each additional semester (\$2,330 per semester for most Arts and Science programs).

Toronto	6,960	6,960	6,960	No continuing fees, students pay entire cost of tuition each additional year.
Dalhousie <sup>8</sup>	7,851- 8,925	9,326	2,442	After paying a flat rate for the duration of the program (usually two years), students pay a continuing registration fee of \$814 per term.

1. Source of Tuition Fee information is the U15 TA Fee Survey, with the exception of Memorial which is from its Web site. All Continuing Fees information has been acquired from each institution's Web site.
2. Graduate fees represent those for standard Arts and Science programs. Where a range is given fees vary by program.
3. Continuing fees have been calculated to reflect what a student would pay for an additional year of study in order to make fees comparable across institutions.
4. One calendar year is equal to three semesters.
5. Effective Fall 2015, the Alberta Government implemented a tuition freeze which remained in effect for the academic year reported.
6. The Masters fee represented is the fee that non-Quebec Canadian students pay. All Canadians, regardless of province, pay the same fee for a Ph.D. program.
7. The University of Western Ontario changed its name to Western University in 2012.
8. Masters and Ph.D. fees represent the fees that non-Nova Scotia Canadian students pay.
