- Where program fees are used instead of per credit hour fees, the cost of tuition for the year is shown, unless otherwise stated. All figures exclude endowment fund contributions, student organization fees, fieldwork fees, material or equipment related fees.
- Fees for Engineering represent those for years 2-5. Fees for Business represent those for years 2-4. Fees for Education represent all years of undergraduate education programs except for years 1-3 of NITEP, which is \$154 per credit hour. Tuition for Dentistry, Medicine and Law is for the 2011-2012 entering cohort.
- Effective Fall 2011, in addition to tuition fees, students in the Faculties of Business, Pharmacy, and Engineering pay Market Modifier Fees. Above fees for Business and Pharmacy include Market Modifier Fees; the Market Modifier Fee for Engineering pertains to particular courses only and therefore is not included in the above fee. Both Law and Medicine include a \$4,436 program differential fee. Dentistry and Dental Hygiene fees include Clinical Operations Fees. Students seeking a degree in Dental Hygiene complete the Diploma program followed by one year in the Degree program.
- The fee per course in the Faculty of Law is \$1002.
- Students in the Diploma in Agriculture program pay half the cost per credit unit. Fee shown is half the cost per credit unit for courses in the Agriculture Degree program. Tuition in the Faculty of Law is based on a 30 credit hour course load.
- The Saskatchewan Collaborative Bachelor of Science in Nursing program (offered jointly by the Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Science and Technology and the University of Regina) is new in Fall 2011.
- The University of Western Ontario changed its name to Western University in 2012. Fees are assessed on a per course or program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Fee shown for Business is a program fee.
- Fees are assessed on a per course or program fee basis. The fee per credit hour was calculated by dividing the stated fees for the program by 30 credit hours (the number of credit hours in an average year). Many programs have different fees for new students and continuing students. In all cases, except Management, tuition shown is that of the 2011-2012 entering cohort. Tuition for Management reflects the fee paid by the continuing group as the entrance cohort pays the same fees as Arts during the first year of their program.
- Students seeking a Degree in Dental Hygiene complete the Diploma program followed by one year in the Degree program.
- Pharmacy students must also pay a compulsory \$1591 clinical fieldwork fee. Dental Hygiene Degree Program requires the prior completion of a Diploma in Dental Hygiene at an accredited institution.
