6. Effective Fall Term 2014, the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences.
7. Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Faculty of Health Sciences.
The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.
