5. The "Pass Only" grades refer to Pass/Fail courses and are not included in the "Average Grade" calculations.
6. The averages are unweighted as to credit hours and are computed using the following scales: A+=4.5 A=4.0 B+=3.5 B=3.0 C+=2.5 C=2.0 D=1.0 F=0
