6. Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's programs and departments joined other academic units within the university. Students in Textile Sciences are now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences. Students in Family Social Sciences are now reported under the Max Rady College of Medicine. Students in Health Sciences/Health Studies are now reported under the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences.
