1. This report excludes courses at or above the 6000 level, as these are associated with graduate programs. Courses at the 6000 level were included in previous reports, so comparisons should be made with caution.
2. The data were taken from the Aurora Student Information System as of June 26, 2020. This table does not include grades of "Continuing", "In Progress", or "Other".
3. Percentages may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
4. The "Pass Only" grades refer to Pass/Fail courses and are not included in the "Average Grade" calculations.
5. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, students were given the option to receive a "pass" grade, instead of a letter grade, in certain courses completed by April 2020. Those courses are excluded from all GPA calculations.
6. The averages are unweighted as to credit hours and are computed using the following scales: A+=4.5 A=4.0 B+=3.5 B=3.0 C+=2.5 C=2.0 D=1.0 F=0
7. A temporary revision to the Grade Point Average Policy was approved by Senate for Winter Term 2020, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Under the revision, students may have certain grades excluded from their term GPA calculations. The average grade is based on only those grades included for GPA calculations.
8. The College of Dentistry changed its name to the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry in 2018.
9. This includes only undergraduates in faculties other than the Max Rady College of Medicine taking Medicine courses.
