Definitions:

Column C: Ph.D. students in any of their first four registrations as Ph.D. students - count one (1) each.

Column D: Ph.D. students in their fifth registration as Ph.D. students - count one-half (1/2) each. Ph.D. students who have been registered for six or more years are not counted.
