 2. An asterisk indicates that the number of credit hours is below 100 in either year. Changes in faculties/colleges/schools containing less than 100 credit hours can show abnormally large differences, therefore these have been identified with (*).
 3. The Colleges/Schools of Medicine, Dentistry, Rehabilitation Sciences and Dental Hygiene determine their workload by numbers of students instead of by credit hours. They are included in the "Taught To" calculations because their students can take credit hours in other faculties/colleges/schools.
 4. Effective Fall Term 2014, the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences.
 5. Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Faculty of Health Sciences. The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.
 6. University 1 (U1) is included in the "Taught To" category as students in this program take credit hours from other faculties/colleges/schools.
 7. Due to rounding, some totals may not match the sum of the individual faculty/college/school figures.
