- Undergraduate Student Credit Hours (UGSCH) are the hours of weight associated with a course indicating the relative weight of the course in the program of studies. There is often a correlation between lecture class hours and hours of credit; for example, a full course carrying six (6) hours of credit may entail three (3) hours of lectures per week, both terms. This report includes: (a) distance education credit hours - students taking all of their courses through a distance method of delivery, such as Independent Study, on-line courses, video conferencing, computer-mediated study, telecourse or community-based study; (b) all courses taught off-campus with stipend from other than faculty, college or school resources; (c) courses taught "on-load" - taught during the summer but considered part of the regular session for load unit purposes. This report excludes (d) credit hours declared as "Challenge for Credit". Beginning Fall 2013-Winter 2014, this report also excludes: (e) 6000-level courses associated with graduate programs. These hours were included in previous reports, so comparisons should be made with caution.
- Credit hour totals reflect combined Fall Term and Winter Term activity, as at November 1 and March 1 respectively. Due to rounding, some totals may not match the sum of the individual department, or faculty/college/school, figures.
- Effective Fall Term 2014, the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences. Comparisons with previous years should be made with caution.
- Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's courses and departments joined other academic units within the university. Textile Sciences is now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences, within Biosystems Engineering. Family Social Sciences is now reported under the College of Medicine, within Community Health Sciences. Core Human Ecology and Health Program, Interdisciplinary are now reported under the Faculty of Health Sciences, as Interdisciplinary Health. 2015 Summer on-load credit hours are associated with the new academic units.
- The Department of Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering changed its name to the Department of Mechanical Engineering in 2013.
- Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Faculty of Health Sciences. The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty. Comparisons with previous years should be made with caution for the College of Medicine and the College of Rehabilitation Sciences.
- The decrease in credit hours is due to a restructuring of the credit hours assigned to courses.
- The Bachelor of Medical Rehabilitation (Physical Therapy) has transitioned to a graduate program. There was no intake for Fall Term 2009 or Fall Term 2011, which resulted in a drop in credit hours for this department.
- The Department of Physiology changed its name to the Department of Physiology and Pathophysiology in 2014.
- Includes credit hours from the accelerated program run during the summer term.
- Effective Fall Term 2015, the College of Nursing has two intakes for the Bachelor of Nursing Program - one in Fall Term and another in Winter Term. In addition, Nursing revised its curriculum in 2015. As a result, credit hour comparisons should be made with caution.
