3. The Colleges/Schools of Dentistry, Rehabilitation Sciences and Dental Hygiene determine their workload by numbers of students instead of by credit hours.

They are included in the "Taught To" calculations because their students can take credit hours in other faculties/colleges/schools.

4. Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's courses and departments joined other academic units within the university. Textile Sciences is now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences.

Family Social Sciences is now reported under the College of Medicine. Core Human Ecology and Health Program, Interdisciplinary are now reported under the Faculty of Health Sciences. Percent changes are not comparable with previous years.

5. Credit hours for the College of Medicine do not reflect Undergraduate Medical Education teaching.

6. University 1 (U1) is included in the "Taught To" category as students in this program take credit hours from other faculties/colleges/schools.
