- Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's courses and departments joined other academic units within the university. Textile Sciences is now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences. Family Social Sciences is now reported under the College of Medicine. Core Human Ecology and Health Program, Interdisciplinary are now reported under the Faculty of Health Sciences. Summer on-load credit hours reflected under the new academic units. Totals are not comparable with previous years.
- Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Faculty of Health Sciences. The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.
- University 1 (U1) is included in the "Taught To" category as students in this program take credit hours from other faculties/colleges/schools.
- Due to rounding, some totals may not match the sum of the individual faculty/college/school figures.
