 - An asterisk (*) indicates that the number of credit hours were below 100 in either year. Changes in faculties/colleges/schools containing fewer than 100 credit hours can show abnormally large differences; therefore, these changes are not reported.
 - Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's courses and departments joined other academic units within the university. Textile Sciences is now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences, within Biosystems Engineering. Family Social Sciences is now reported under the College of Medicine, within Community Health Sciences. Core Human Ecology and Health Program, Interdisciplinary are now reported under the Faculty of Health Sciences, as Interdisciplinary Health. Totals are not comparable, therefore percent changes are not shown.
 - The Department of Physiology changed its name to the Department of Physiology and Pathophysiology in 2014.
 - Effective Fall Term 2015, the College of Nursing has two intakes for the Bachelor of Nursing Program - one in Fall Term and another in Winter Term. In addition, Nursing revised its curriculum in 2015. As a result, credit hour comparisons should be made with caution.
