1. The Manitoba Education and Training Department provides financial support toward the ACCESS programs.
ACCESS programs enhance accessibility for priority groups consisting of northern Manitobans, Indigenous peoples, single parents, women, low-income earners, immigrants, refugees, visible minorities, and people with disabilities.
2. The reporting of degrees is based on a calendar year (February, May, and October graduands).
3. Program is exclusively for students of Indigenous ancestry.
4. In 2007, the Faculty of Nursing (now the College of Nursing), in partnership with the Access Program (under Extended Education), developed the Aboriginal Nursing Cohort Initiative (ANCI). In 2015, ANCI became solely under the operation of the College of Nursing.
5. UMAP includes students in the Education Access Program (EAP).
