1. Definition of a Continuing Education Unit (CEU):

CEU is used to convert student contact hours where one (1) CEU is equivalent to ten (10) student contact hours.

Stated another way, one contact hour is equal to 0.1 CEU.

The total number of CEUs for any course is determined by multiplying the number of contact hours x 0.1 x the number of students.
