8. The Faculty of Health Sciences changed its name to the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences in 2016.

9. The College of Medicine changed its name to the Max Rady College of Medicine in 2016.

10. Effective Fall Term 2015, Family Social Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Max Rady College of Medicine.

11. The Bachelor of Medical Rehabilitation (Physical Therapy) has transitioned to a Master's program. The Master's of Physical Therapy program had its first intake in Fall Term 2012.
