1. Effective Fall Term 2014, the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences.
2. Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's programs and departments joined other academic units within the university. Prior to the 2016 Summer Term, students are reflected in Human Ecology. Beginning with the 2016 Summer Term, students in Textile Sciences are reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences. Students in Family Social Sciences are reported under the Max Rady College of Medicine. Students in Health Sciences/Health Studies are reported under the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences. Year-over-year comparisons should be made with caution.
3. Enrolment in the integrated program is shown in Music for years 3 and 4 and in Education for year 5.
4. Beginning in 2013, increases due partially to restructuring of co-op work terms.
5. Beginning in 2017, the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences has an option for admission directly from high school.
6. Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences. The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.
7. The Faculty of Health Sciences changed its name to the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences in 2016.
8. The College of Dentistry changed its name to the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry in 2018.
9. The College of Medicine changed its name to the Max Rady College of Medicine in 2016.
10. Decrease in enrolment due to a change in curriculum.
11. Includes William Norrie Centre, Distance and Northern programs.
12. The University 1 program was introduced in 1998-99. Most "new" students, with limited or no university experience, have registered under this program.
13. Graduate Studies includes pre-master's, master's, doctoral, occasional and diploma students. Graduate totals include only students taking credit courses in Summer Term.
