- Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's programs and departments joined other academic units within the university.
Students in Textile Sciences are now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences. Students in Family Social Sciences are now reported under the Max Rady College of Medicine. Students in Health Sciences/Health Studies are now reported under the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences.

- Effective 2003, newly admitted students in interdisciplinary graduate programs are reflected in the Faculty of their advisor.
- Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences.
The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.
- The Faculty of Health Sciences changed its name to the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences in 2016.
- The College of Medicine changed its name to the Max Rady College of Medicine in 2016.
- In 2017, Medical Microbiology changed its name to Medical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases. Students enrolled prior to 2017 will graduate under the previous program name.
- Physiology & Pathophysiology was previously reported as Physiology.
- In 2016, Medical Rehabilitation changed its name to Rehabilitation Sciences. Beginning in Fall Term 2016, newly admitted students are reported under Rehabilitation Sciences.
- The Master of Social Work in Indigenous Knowledges was new in Fall Term 2016.
- Beginning Fall Term 2014, the Master's in Social Work has a revised program structure. Students enrolled prior to 2014 will complete under the previous program.
Leadership, Management & Policy is a stream under the revised structure.
