2. The Faculty of Health Sciences changed its name to the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences in 2016.
3. Beginning in 2017, the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences has an option for admission directly from high school.
4. The College of Dentistry changed its name to the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry in 2018.
5. Other Dentistry includes B.Sc. Dentistry students and students in the International Dentist Degree Program.
6. The College of Medicine changed its name to the Max Rady College of Medicine in 2016.
7. Other Medicine includes B.Sc. Medicine students and physicians enrolled in Continuing Medical Education courses.
8. Effective Fall Term 2015, the College of Nursing has two intakes for the Bachelor of Nursing Program - one in Fall Term and another in Winter Term. This has resulted in decreased Fall Term enrolment in 2015, 2016, and 2017.
9. Decrease in enrolment in Pharmacy due to transition from B.Sc. Pharmacy to PharmD program, new in Fall Term 2019.
