1. Direct Entry programs admit students directly from high school. Transit programs allow students to transit in automatically from University 1. (Arts/Science figures are separated into students who formally applied to Arts and Science and those who transited automatically from University 1). University Entry requires university study before application to the program.
2. Figures for 2013-14 are based on a previous admissions system, and reflect first choice applicant data only. Figures are provided for general comparisons only, and should be used with caution. Where direct entry/university entry breakdowns not available, figures shown as university entry.
3. Applicant data from the new application system, Apply Yourself, introduced in 2014-15.
4. Includes students who have accepted, or were offered, admission.
5. Registered status for 2014-15 as at end of term; Registered status for 2013-14 as at November 1.
6. Effective Fall Term 2014, the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences.
7. Excludes B.Mus./B.Ed. program.
8. Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Faculty of Health Sciences. The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.
9. Within the UCN program, The Pas and Thompson sites each have a target of 20.
10. Students no longer admitted to year one. Prior to applying for admission to year two, all applicants must now complete a minimum of 30 credit hours.
11. Physical Education and Kinesiology have a combined target of 100.
12. Law target includes five places for half-time students and five places for Indigenous students.
