1. Graduate figures include students continuing in a course or thesis over more than one term.
2. Winter Term reports are based on data extracted as at March 1. Winter Term 2017 used an adjusted date of March 15 as that term began two weeks later than usual.
3. An asterisk (*) indicates that enrolment was below 15 students in either year. Percent changes in faculties containing fewer than 15 students can show abnormally large differences, therefore these changes are not reported.
4. Effective Fall Term 2015, the Department of Textile Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences. Comparisons with previous years should be made with caution.
5. As at March 1 (Winter Term 2017), there were 115 Joint Master's Program students in the programs shared by the University of Manitoba and the University of Winnipeg (130 in Winter Term 2016). Based on workload calculations, the following JMPs have been reported under the University of Manitoba:
