- The School of Art introduced its first graduate program, the Master of Fine Art, in Fall Term 2010.

- The Ph.D. program in Native Studies was new in Fall Term 2010.
- In 2011, the Collège universitaire de Saint-Boniface (CUSB) changed its name to Université de Saint-Boniface (USB).
- Includes students in the Canadian Studies program at St. Boniface taking courses at the U of M.
- The Master's program in Pediatric Dentistry was new in Fall Term 2011.
- Includes students in the Education program at St. Boniface taking courses at the U of M.
- The Ph.D. in Applied Health Sciences is offered jointly by Human Ecology, Kinesiology and Recreation Management, Nursing and the School of Medical Rehabilitation. It is reported under Graduate Studies.
- The interdisciplinary Ph.D. program in Cancer Control is offered jointly by the Faculty of Nursing and the Department of Community Health Sciences. It is reported under Graduate Studies.
- Effective 2003, newly admitted students in interdisciplinary studies are reflected in the Faculty of their advisor.
- A Joint Master's Program in Peace and Conflict Studies, with the University of Winnipeg, was introduced in Fall Term 2010.
- The Bachelor of Medical Rehabilitation (Physical Therapy) is transitioning to a Master's program. The Master's of Physical Therapy program had its first intake in Fall Term 2012.
- Includes those students taking a Diploma in Population Health.
- The Ph.D. program in Nursing is new in Fall Term 2012.
- Nurse Practitioner reported previously within Nursing.
