2. Year in program is based on the length of time from the program start date, with three terms being a year. Year in program has been adjusted for parenting or exceptional leaves.
3. Students in Individual Interdisciplinary Studies (IIS) are shown under the faculty of their advisor. If the faculty does not offer a Ph.D. program, the student is shown under Graduate Studies.
4. New includes any graduate students starting in the Winter, Summer or Fall Term in 2018.
5. Biomedical Engineering previously reported under Graduate Studies. Comparisons to previous years should be made with caution.
6. The Applied Health Sciences Ph.D. is offered jointly by Kinesiology and Recreation Management, Nursing, and Rehabilitation Sciences.
7. The Cancer Control Ph.D. is offered jointly by the College of Nursing and the Department of Community Health Sciences.
8. The College of Dentistry changed its name to the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry in 2018.
9. In 2017, Medical Microbiology changed its name to Medical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases. Students enrolled prior to 2017 will graduate under the previous program name.
10. Students on an Exceptional or Parenting Leave are not required to register while on leave and are therefore not included in the Fall Term headcounts. They have been added as part-time students in this report only.
