2. Year in program is based on the length of time from the program start date, with three terms being a year. Year in program has been adjusted for parenting or exceptional leaves.
3. Students in Individual Interdisciplinary Studies (IIS) are shown under the faculty of their advisor. If the faculty does not offer a Ph.D. program, the student is shown under Graduate Studies.
4. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting changes to program/course delivery, Fall Term 2020 may not be comparable to previous years.
5. New includes any graduate students starting in the Winter, Summer or Fall Term in 2020.
6. Beginning in Fall Term 2020, within the Department of Economics, new Ph.D. and Master's students will be admitted to either the Economics & Econometrics stream or the Economics & Society stream.
7. The Faculty of Engineering changed its name to the Price Faculty of Engineering in 2020.
8. The Applied Health Sciences Ph.D. is offered jointly by Kinesiology and Recreation Management, Nursing, and Rehabilitation Sciences.
9. Students on an Exceptional or Parenting Leave are not required to register while on leave and are therefore not included in the Fall Term headcounts. They have been added as part-time students in this report only.
