4. The University 1 program was introduced in 1998-99. Most "new" students, with limited or no university experience, have registered under this program. Students must complete 24 credit hours under University 1 (and may complete up to 30) before transferring into a degree program. Beginning in 2007, the requirements to transit changed requiring a minimum GPA of 2.0.
