1. An asterisk (*) indicates that enrolment was below 25 in either year. Percent changes in faculties/colleges/schools containing fewer than 25 students can show abnormally large differences, therefore these changes are not reported.
2. Effective Fall Term 2014, the Department of Human Nutritional Sciences moved from the Faculty of Human Ecology to the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences. Totals are not comparable; therefore, percent changes are not shown.
3. Enrolment in the integrated program is shown in Music for years 3 and 4 and in Education for year 5.
4. Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Faculty of Health Sciences. The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.
5. Students in the Respiratory Therapy program were reported under the School of Medical Rehabilitation in Summer Term 2014.
6. Effective July 1, 2015 the Faculty of Human Ecology closed and its programs and departments joined other academic units within the university. For Summer Term 2015, students in these programs are reflected in Human Ecology.

8. The University 1 program was introduced in 1998-99. Most "new" students, with limited or no university experience, have registered under this program.
