5. Beginning in 2017, the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences has an option for admission directly from high school.
6. The College of Dentistry changed its name to the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry in 2018.
7. Enrolment in the College of Nursing for Summer Term 2020 includes students completing courses suspended in the previous Winter Term.
8. Nursing revised its curriculum in 2015, resulting in decreases in enrolment in subsequent terms.
9. Includes William Norrie Centre, Distance and Northern programs.
10. The University 1 program was introduced in 1998-99. Most "new" students, with limited or no university experience, have registered under this program.
11. Graduate Studies includes pre-master's, master's, doctoral, occasional and diploma students. Graduate totals include only students taking credit courses in Summer Term.
