Staff in Textile Sciences are now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences. Staff in Family Social Sciences are now reported under the Max Rady College of Medicine.
Staff in Health Sciences/Health Studies are now reported under the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences.
- Effective November 2014, the Faculties of Dentistry, Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy became colleges in the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences.
The College of Rehabilitation Sciences (formerly, the School of Medical Rehabilitation) and the School of Dental Hygiene also became part of the new faculty.
- Due to re-structuring within the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences, there is a considerable number of individuals now represented directly under this Faculty, where previously under the Max Rady College of Medicine.
This re-structuring of the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences is ongoing and may affect future reports.
